We hope you are all having a great summer vacation! It is our intent that we answer any questions you may have regarding activities and athletics for the 2019-2020 school year. For additional questions about athletics, please call the Athletics Director, Rob McMains, at 425-431-5345. The LHS **Royal Rally** will be Tuesday, August 20, from 5pm – 8pm. You can come to LHS for one-stop back to school shopping. You will be able to get information about school clubs; pay for a yearbook, sports participation fee, ASB card and parking permit, ASB gear sale; and have questions answered about the upcoming year. Cash, check and card are accepted. **Schedules will be available at the Royal Rally!**

Chromebooks: Freshman will be getting their Chromebooks as part of the Link Crew Freshman Orientation on August 29th. All upper classmen who did not keep their Chromebooks over the summer can pick up their Chromebooks on August 30th from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm.

Online Payments: The website for online payments is: <https://wa-edmonds.intouchrecepting.com/>. The parent login and password is the same as the parent login and password for Skyward. The student login is the student ID number, and the password is their full last name. Within this site you can check for any outstanding fines (fines are no longer accessed through Skyward). You can also pay for various items such as class fees, ASB Cards, lunch money, etc.

Class Schedules: 2019-2020 Class Schedules will be distributed at the Royal Rally. You will not be able to access your schedule online until after August 29th. Come to the Royal Rally to get your schedule!

ASB Cards: The cost for a 2019-2020 ASB card is \$50.00. ASB cards allow free entrance to all home athletic contests, discounts on away sporting events, yearbooks, parking fees, dances and other admission fees at LHS. ASB does not receive funds from the district or state and is self-supporting, while helping sponsor activities and athletics at LHS. **It is required that any student participating in extra-curricular activities such as sports, music, drama and other clubs purchase an ASB card.** ASB cards may be purchased during summer hours (see times on reverse) or once school begins. A temporary card will be issued for use until picture ID/ASB cards are distributed on Picture Day, September 11.

ID Cards: All students enrolled at LHS are expected to carry a student ID. The Activities Office provides one ID per student at no charge. Replacement cards will cost \$5.00. The ID card is also used to identify those students who have purchased an ASB card, intra-district students, students with internet access and to check out school materials. ID cards only, will be distributed on Picture Day, September 11.

Yearbooks: The cost for the 2019-2020 LHS Yearbook will be \$60.00 with an ASB card and \$65.00 without an ASB card through January. Prices go up to \$70.00 with ASB and \$75.00 without ASB in February. You may place a down payment of \$30.00 to reserve your copy. Yearbooks must be purchased and paid for **in full**, in the ASB office by the time of pickup. Cash, checks, and credit/debit cards are accepted. Make checks payable to "Edmonds School District." **Extras will not be ordered and we will sell out.**

Parking Permits: It is required that all vehicles parked on campus during school hours have a valid permit displayed at all times. Students must pick up the parking permit application from the Main Office, complete and return the application to the Main Office where they can purchase their parking permits. Parking permits are \$55.00 without an ASB card and \$35.00 with an ASB card. At the beginning of the 2nd semester, permits are reduced to \$35.00 and \$25.00. Part-time Running Start Students **must** have parking permits as well. If you are a Running Start student who is here for less than three periods, please come to the Main Office for the pricing of your permit. There are no refunds on parking permits. Vehicles parked on campus without a valid

permit or illegally parked will be subject to a parking ticket of \$30.00 per infraction. Permits may be purchased during summer hours or once school begins.

All vehicles parked on campus will be expected to have permits by September 25. After September 25, parking rules will be strictly enforced. It is a \$30.00 offense to park on campus without a permit, and a \$30.00 offense to park in an undesignated student parking spot. Permits are limited and will be sold on a first-come, first-serve basis.

School Pictures: School pictures will be taken on September 11. Picture order packets will be sent home in September. For security reasons, all students will be required to have their picture taken whether purchasing packets or not. These pictures will also be used for ID cards.

Senior Yearbook Photos: Senior Yearbook Headshots may be taken with any professional photography studio. Seniors may select the headshot they want included in the yearbook and must submit them by the end of October 2019.

Royals Athletics

Fall Sports:

Fall sports offered are football, boys and girls cross country, volleyball, boys tennis, girls swimming and girls soccer. **The first practices of the season are scheduled for Monday, August 26th with the exception of football and cheer which begin Wednesday, August 21st.** To be eligible for the first practice and competition athletes must complete the following:

Before the first practice, athletes must complete:

- Athletic Eligibility Packet
- Current medical/physical examination (most physicals are good for 24 calendar months)
- All school fines must be paid.
- Must have a current ASB card (\$50 for the 2019-20 school year).

Before participating in a competition, athletes must:

- Must have attempted at least 2.5 credits during spring semester 18-19 and attempting 2.5 credits during fall semester 19-20.
- Can have failed no more than one class during spring semester 2018-19.
- Running Start and Homeschool students must submit a separate contract to the Athletic Director prior to participating in a competition.
- Pay a \$100 Sports Participation Fee (waived if qualified for free/reduced lunch).

ELIGIBILITY PAPERWORK:

NEW Requirement for Sports Physicals beginning in 2019-20: In order for an athlete to be cleared to practice, the athlete must have a physical that is valid for the **entire** season.

- 2019-20 Athletic paperwork is now available online and can be completed any time at <http://edmonds-schools.rankonesport.com/>.
- Athletes are not automatically cleared if they submit paperwork online.
- Athletes must either check-in with the LHS Athletics Office (see office hours below) or receive an email that confirms their eligibility to practice.
- **Pre-Checked Athletic Paperwork:** Beginning the week of August 19th, online paperwork will be pre-checked. If an athlete has completed online paperwork, purchased a \$50 ASB card (either online or in

person), has no fines, and a current physical is on file, that athlete will not need to check-in at the school. **An email will be sent to students who meet this criteria.**

Athletics Office/Activities Office Summer Hours: You may purchase ASB cards and yearbooks, and turn in completed athletic forms during the following summer days and hours. You may write a single check for all purchases. **Please make checks payable to Edmonds School District.**

Note: Fall Sports Athletic Paperwork will not be collected between Thursday, Aug. 29th and Tuesday, September 3rd. Paperwork will be collected again starting on Wednesday, September 4th.

Some reminders for the new school year from the LHS Counselors:

- You should check your progress toward graduation on Skyward; make sure you are earning credits at the pace you should. Students in the class of 2020 are required to complete 22 credits to graduate; beginning with the Class of 2021 and beyond, students must meet the new 24 credit graduation requirement. Each student from those classes needs to complete 6 credits per year. So students should have the following credits at the start of each year:

Class of 2022/Sophomores – 6.0 Class of 2021/Juniors – 12.0 Class of 2020/Seniors – 16.0

- Schedule changes are difficult as classes are very full. Your counselor will change your schedule if the change is necessary to correct a scheduling error (ex. immediate graduation requirement need, two classes same period) and a limited number of student-initiated changes may be possible on a case-by-case basis. Try to take care of these changes before school begins on September 5th.
- Please make sure your family's personal information (address, phone number, email address, etc.) is correct. Review this information on Skyward and make any appropriate changes. Address changes must have proof of address. If you need help with this, you can call the Counseling Office support staff beginning August 23rd.
- The Counselors will be back in their offices on August 20th for phone calls and to take appointments. Call our office at (425) 431-7530 if we can help you in any way to prepare for the 2019-20 school year.
