# **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**



### <u>ART</u>

LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:

1.0 CREDIT

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Minimum 4 year college requirement:

1.0 CREDIT\*

\*California colleges want 1.0 art classes often including advanced art classes

## **WORLD LANGUAGES**

Not required for graduation

Can use personal pathway of courses suited to your plans for after high school.

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- Minimum 4 year college requirement:
  - 2.0 3.0 credits one language
- Stamp Test credits are often accepted, check with the college.

## **ENGLISH**

LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:
 4.0 credits

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Minimum 4 year college requirement :
 4.0 credits





## **SOCIAL STUDIES**

- LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:

3.5 credits

 WA State History requirement met in US History, AP US History or in Middle School

Minimum 4 year college requirement:

3.0 credits



# **MATH**

LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:

3.0 credits

Algebra 1
Geometry
Choice of Financial Algebra,
Algebra 2, or Algebra 2 Honors
for 3rd year Math
IEP students follow their path
established with their case
manager

Minimum 4 year college requirement:

3.0 credits

Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2 or Algebra 2 Honors required Want "as much math as possible" Require a Math or Math-based science in the senior year (Chemistry, Physics, Statistics, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, etc.)





LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:

3.0 credits

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Minimum 4 year college requirement:

3.0 credits

Physics course needed for Engineering majors
WWU requires full year of chemistry or physics

- LHS Graduation and community college entrance requirement:

1.5 credits

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Minimum 4 year college requirement:

Not required



### PERSONAL FINANCE

 LHS Graduation and Community College requirement:

.5 credit

- Take in 12th grade
- Accounting 1 or Financial Algebra are equivalencies

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Minimum 4 year college requirement:
 Not required

### **GENERAL ELECTIVES**

- LHS Graduation and community college requirement:

5.5 credits

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Minimum 4 year college requirement:

Not required

# WHAT ELSE DO I HAVE TO DO TO GRADUATE?

- Complete High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP) in Naviance
- Pass State Tests (when available) SBA English, Math, take Science
   OR-
  - Pass 2.0 credits in one CTE Pathway
    - OR-
  - Pass college level English and math classes (CHS or Running Start)
    - OR-
  - Take/pass Bridge to College English and Math
    - -OR-
  - Take/pass AP English/Math and earn passing grade on AP Tests

# How to view your grad requirements?

- 1. Login to your skyward account. LHS Homepage
- 2. On the left scroll down to "Graduation Requirements."
- 3. "In progress" means the classes you are in this year.
- 4. The "Remaining" column is what you still need to complete.
- If the "In Progress" and "Remaining" are the same amount, this means you are currently taking all that you need.
- Once you pass the "in progress" classes, they will move to the "Completed" column
- 7. If a class is remaining, and not in progress you need to take/pass this course to graduate
